ELEMENTARY CHARGE PROCEDURE

First concern in elementary schools is that we do not let the students go hungry, which is resolved with the roll and milk or fruit and milk at a cost of \$.50.

Parent Link will call parents once a week. The calls will be made on Tuesday evenings to notify parents of charges that are \$4.50 or more.

Managers will check the report the next morning to see which parents received the calls. If there are parents on the list who did not receive the call, managers will send charge letters to those parents through the regular postal system.

Only elementary schools will be called regarding cafeteria charges.

Student's hands will no longer be stamped when students are out of money.

It will not be necessary for school staff to discuss charges with students, other than when they are given a roll and milk or a fruit and milk.

Weekly letters **may** also be sent home to parents.

Letters that are sent home to parents will include the charge procedures, and information on applying for free and reduced meal benefits or paying through the mealpay.com system.

Parents will have an opportunity to call the Food Service Office to request extended charges for special circumstances.

Students will be allowed to charge only five meals (with breakfast this will be more than five meals)

Students receiving reduced benefits will continue to receive a lunch at the cost of \$.40 cents.

This procedure continues to the end of the school year. School may not discontinue allowing charges during the last weeks of school.
